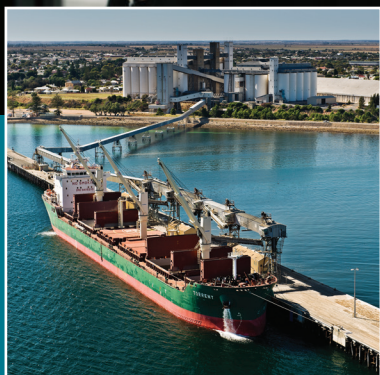
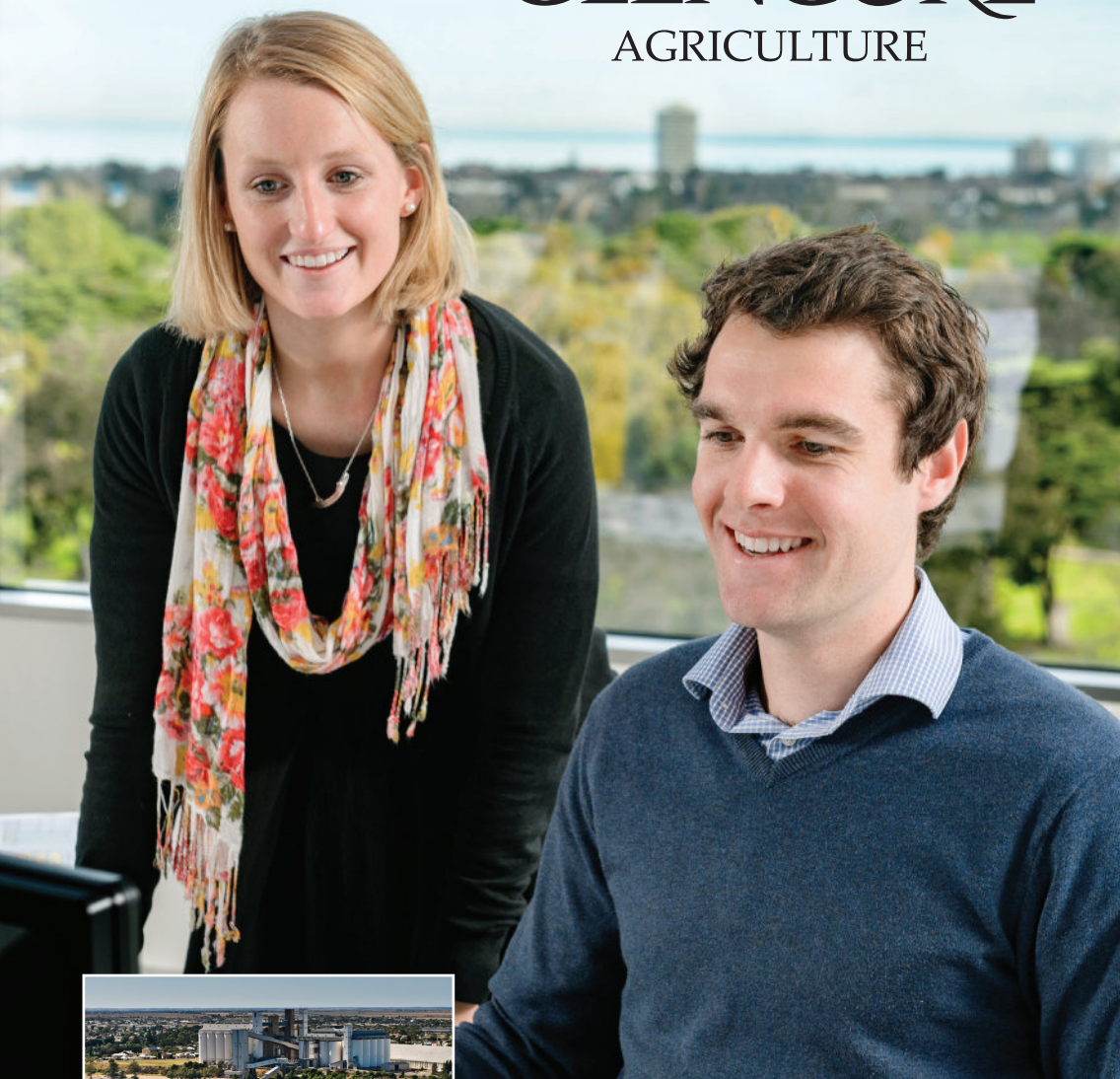

Glencore Agriculture is one of the leading exporters of Australian grain. With strong relationships at all stages of the supply chain, the company operates a world-class marketing, storage and logistics network for Australia’s commodities.

Glencore Agriculture buys wheat, barley, oilseeds, pulses, sorghum and cotton direct from Australian growers, with offices in SA, WA, Victoria, NSW and Queensland.

We market 8-10 million tonnes of grain per annum to domestic and international customers in bulk and containers. We are the largest importer of protein meals into Australia and supply product to a range of feed manufacturers and customers. Our operations include Viterra’s storage and handling network spanning key growing regions in SA, western Victoria and NSW.

We are part of the global Glencore Agriculture business, a leader in originating, handling, processing and marketing agricultural commodities, with operations in more than 35 countries worldwide.
